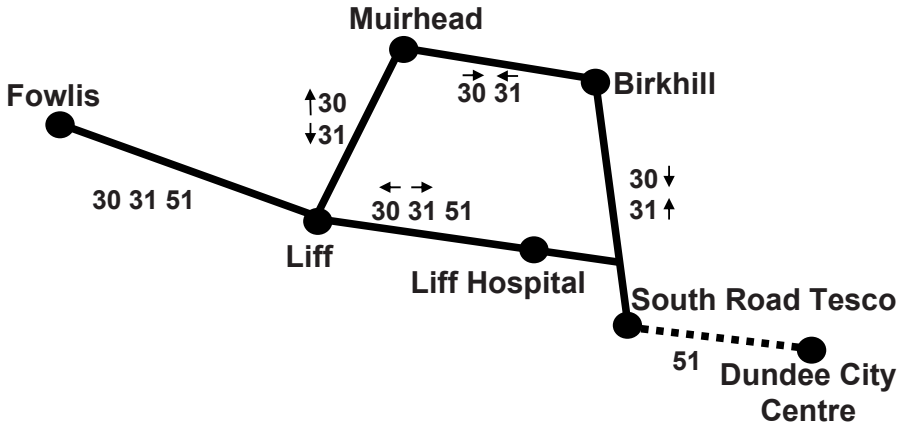

Changes since the May 2009 edition of this timetable

- To meet the requirements of staff at Liff Hospital, the 12:36 Service 31 journey from South Road Tesco will now run as a Service 30, whilst the 19:36 Service 30 journey will now run as a Service 31.

Services on public holidays

No services will operate on 25 December or 1 January. On 26 December and 2 January, a Sunday Service usually operates. On public holidays, a normal weekday service will generally be provided, though passengers are strongly advised to look out for on-bus notices regarding public holiday services. Alternatively, passengers can contact the relevant operator or Traveline for clarification.
